RECOVIDERY ASSISTS LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS

During the last 90 days, your community foundation has been working on the frontlines to assist with COVID recovery. In March, CBF established the COVID-19 Fund to allow individuals, businesses, and other charitable organizations a vehicle for charitable giving for COVID relief. After establishing the fund, CBF reached communities and offered this opportunity. 30 days later, we had gathered \$126,000. The following businesses and organizations provided charitable gifts: PUD Pay-It-Forward Fund \$11,000, Grant County Industrial Alliance \$10,000, Perigee Fund \$15,000, Microsoft \$56,000, Sabey Data Center \$10,000 in Chromebooks, CBF Sustaining Endowment \$20,000, Ferne Daniel "Help Our Children" Fund \$5,000 and anonymous donations \$2,500.

We are so appreciative for the gifts and during these unprecedented times, we have been dispersing relief funds to organizations as fast as possible. In April, we opened a ReCOVIDery grant program through our website and accepted

applications through May 31. We have assisted every eligible application. We focused on food security, homeless, first responders, small-business support through chambers, and nonprofits that focus on seniors, family, youth, and mental health services. 60 organizations have benefited from ReCOVIDery. CBF is truly a gathering place for generosity. Our mission is to improve and shape our communities through philanthropy and through this horrific pandemic, CBF has been able to serve communities and showcases philanthropy's power.

Together, we are better! Thank you to everyone who is part of our community foundation family. We are 24 years strong! Your generous hearts give our organization a healthy philanthropic pulse.
